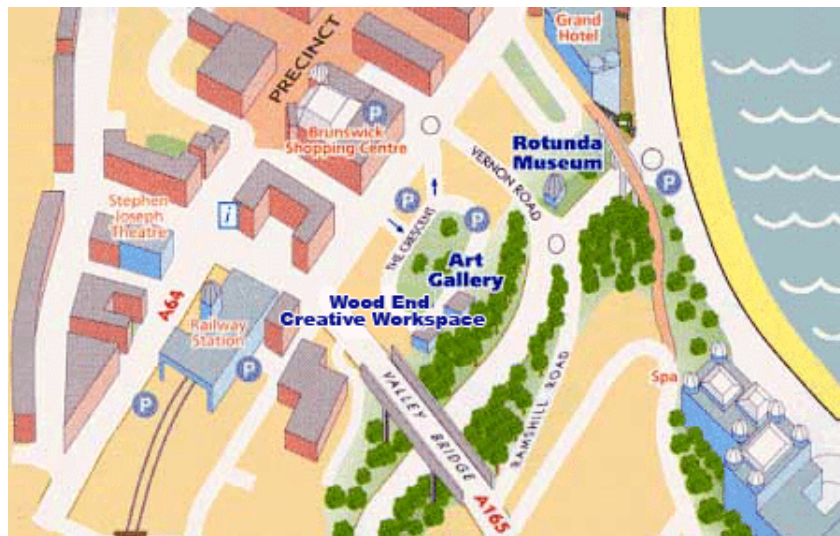

All Scarborough Museums trust venues are situated in Scarborough town centre. Scarborough Art Gallery and Scarborough Collections are situated on the Crescent, to the rear of the Brunswick Centre. The Rotunda overlooks the South Bay close to the sea front.

- Interact with ammonites, belemnites and maybe even Dinosaurs!

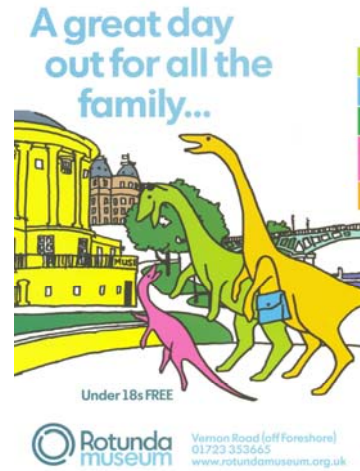

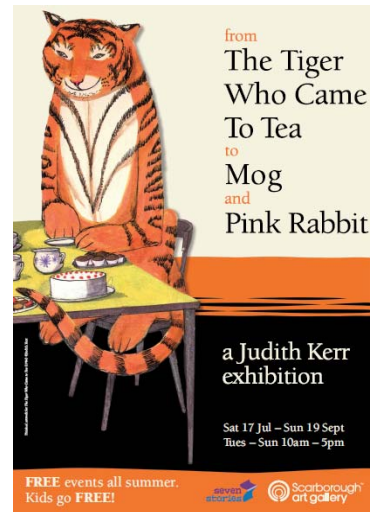
